



Women's Leadership Award

Winner: Mary C Rabling

Mary Rabling has provided long and continued service as a mentor and leader since commencing her surveying course at RMIT in 1985. Mary was the second woman by a matter of a few weeks in 1992, to be granted a surveying licence in Victoria. In 1993 she was a recipient of the prestigious J.G. Gillespie Gold Medal Prize and around this time acted as a consultant for the Women in Surveying Project at RMIT.

Mary is a foundation member of SSI, she has served on the Victorian Regional Committee and was elected Region Chair from 2007-2008, and then held the position of Treasurer from 2009-2014 in what then became SSSI. She was one of the early organisers of SSSI Women in Spatial group and has been a member of the Land Surveying Commission Sub Committee since its inception.
